Treyzinski's 27-year-old business will still have a spot in the center. "They've been with the cen-

ter for a long time. They're a fixture." The completion of a deal

between Kimco and Starbucks would enable the second big name addition in recent weeks. In late August, it was announced that Border's Outlet will open Oct. 10 or 11, in a nearby strip mall operated by Center Holding Company.

Despite Kimco's caution, Farmington city officials are talking as if it's a done deal.

"No question, it's a star quality name, a name people recognize," Richards said. "It's exactly the right kind of retailer we're looking for. It's a real coup for them to be interested in our community."

Richards explained that the "future of downtown" is in specialty retailers, with a similar customer base in mind. "If you draw someone to one of them, they'll likely shop at all of them."

Pasta Stop starts

Other changes to the downtown area include Monday's opening of The Pasta Stop, on Farmington just south of Grand River and a new money island restaurant set to soon open in the former Downtown Cafe, also in the Downtown Farmington Center.

According to Bob Sherman, general manager of The Pasta Stop, there are reasons why retailers and restaurants are being attracted to the city.

"It's the location and feel of the community," said Sherman, saying first-day business went reasonably well. "Any community where the people feel safe to walk and window shop is great."

Sherman said his eatery is more of a carry-out establishment than the full-service competitor just across Farmington Road, Luigi's Trattoria.
