Splashy styling and room for five — without a can opener

This new Impreza 2.5 RS is an addi-

This new Impreza 2.5 RS is an addi-tion to the Impreza line, sort of giving this unique family of ears a new splash of sportiness. There are gold aluminum alloy wheels, projector beam fog lights in front, leather steering wheel and shift knob, driver's footrest, an over-sized rear deck spoiler and tasteful black aerodynamic ground effects, plue a sport tailpipe cover. Really good job in the styling arean, guys.

the styling arena, guys.

The look of the Impreza 2.5 RS is strikingly similar to the car used in the FIA World Rally Championship series. Subaru has won the manufacturer's championship two years in a row and presently holds the title. Even the hood scoop and passive vents are a direct tiein to the rallye car.

Also new this year is a redesigned dash and instrument cluster and door punels. Instrumentation is analog, of course. There's a new center console design, and it incorporates a storage

compartment with a lid that doubles as a comfortable armrest.

On the top of the dash is a mounted tray with a lid. The area is rather smallish and I really couldn't think of anything you could put in there, except maybe lunch or parking money. Maybe a couple of Kleenex or something; noth-

ing more.

This five-passenger Impreza can accommodate five people easily without the use of a can opener. The four outboard passengers have three-point manual seat belts. The front passengers have height-adjustable belts as well. The center rear passenger has a lapbelt

only.

I didn't like the front seats. They're fully reclining buckets. The rear seats are bench. Those I did like.

Also what I didn't like was the diago-nal contrasting pattern that was a dif-

The windshield wipers had acrody-namic fins attached that distracted me when working. They take up valuable visibility in a harder-than-normal rain-storm. Subaru outlitted the wipers that way to further give it a performance

My final concern is about the shortthrow 5-speed manual transmission. On more than one occasion, I'd have it in first or second and advance to the next gear and it would almost jump. A fellow auto writer took it for a spin and agreed

with me.

The Impreza 2.5 RS is powered by a (you guessed it) 2.5-liter 4-cylinder horizontally opposed boxer engine that's

Subaru's signature powerplant. It's a strong engine that gets you where you want to go in a hurry. The mileage is nothing to sneeze at, either: 22 mpg in the city, 28 on the highway.

At first 1 squawked at the price: \$19,690. I thought, well, that's a tad steep for a subcompact. Heck, you can almost get an Outhack Sport for that (a shrewd friend did. too).
