Discuss who will make the decision about your health care if you become unstable. Discuss the kind of health care decisions you should make for the older adults you care for. Learn your legal options and what is best for

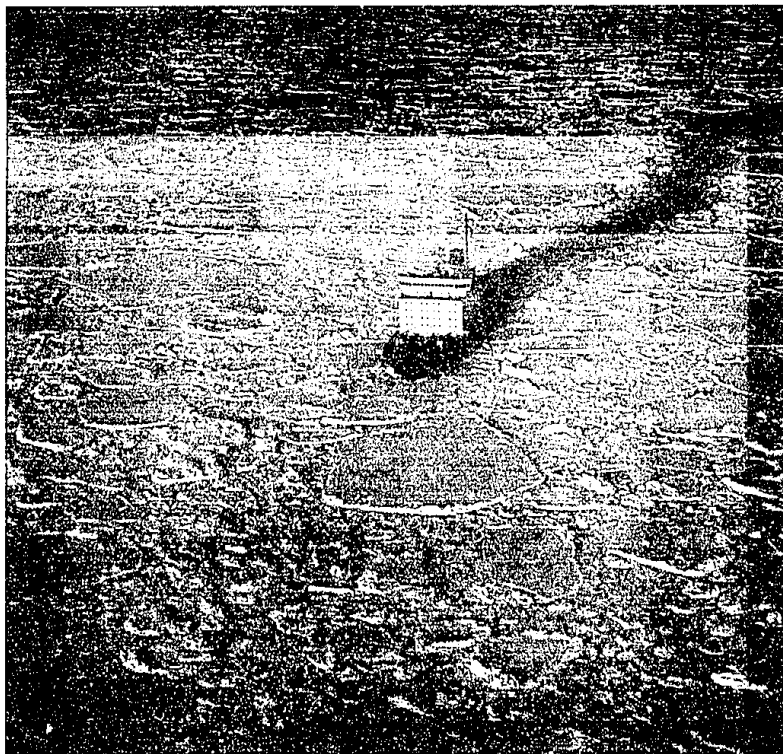
