At exactly the same time, current law gave to one person, their mother, the right to determine whether these children would be born or not. Some day, hopefully soon, we must face up to the dilemma davances in medical science have created in our abortion policy and legislation.

This is particularly evident in the current debate over late term, or partial-birth, abortions. In these cases, the right to "choose" is extended even into the birth process itself.

The current law states that there is a difference between the child's right to life according to whether it is completely born or not.

It is considered legal and appropriate to terminate the life of the child even when a portion of the child's body as left, or been removed from the mother's womb. but the child's head has not.
