and kept to himself, they said.

It was the fourth traffic fatality this year in the Hills and the fourth involving an elderly person, Green said. The other people who were killed in traffic accidents were 81, 72 and 75 years old.

Two people died as result of injuries sustained when a driver, thinking her foot was on the brake, hit the gas and the cap shot in reverse into a pole, he said.
