Senior Mahogany Fletcher and freshman Temica Clayton had four first places to lead the Hawks to victory in the girls meet.

Fletcher won the long jump (16-4½), 100 dash (13.0) and anchored two winning relay teams. Clayton won the 200 (28.4) and participated in three relay victories.

Clayton, Sierra Colbert and Fletcher teamed with Emily Mayberry to win the 400 relay (53.2) and Lisa Rosemary for first place in the 800 relay (1:52). Clayton was the anchorperson on the 1,600 relay team, following Marina DeMeyer, Becky Zak and Kim Washington as the Hawks finished first in 4:22.

Harrison's Kerstin Andziewski was a double winner in the shot put (31-2½) and discus (83-5). Zak won the 400 (1:04.1), Mayberry the 100 hurdles (18.3) and Yoko Minowa the high jump (4-10).

The Hawks also claimed first place in the shuttle hurdle relay with a record time of 1:08. Mayberry, Amanda Gardner, Keyra French and Rosemary eclipsed the time set two years ago by North of 1:09.5.

"The city meet is a big thing for the girls on the team," Harrison girls coach Mark Babcock said. "Winning it is something they pride themselves on; so it's certainly a big win for us. We looked good overall and, hopefully, it's something we can build on."

Farmington's Natalie Dawson had three first places, winning the 1,600 (5:59) and 3,200 (12:50) runs and helping the Falcons win the 3,200 relay. Ellen Adams, Kristin DeBorde, Beth Jager and Dawson combined for a 10:59 time.

Adams also won the 800 run (2:37). North's Lauren Turner won the pole vault (6-3) and Katie Callahan the 300 hurdles (50.95).

The Hawks had second places from Erica Berg in the shot put and discus, Lynn Rossi, pole vault (6-6); DeMeyer, high jump (4-10); and Karolyn Knutson, 800.
