The mountain biking guide is
the latest in an excellent series of
books from Pegg Legg om mountain and road biking trips in the

handle the tough trails. Each trail is rated for difficulty from easy to strenuous. In addition to McLelland's

easy to strenuous. In addition to McLelland's trails, Karen Gentry offers 10 UP road tours for a complete look at biking in the UP. Gentry is the author of two books on riding in the Lower Peninsula. Of course, you might be a little hesitant to go too far into McLelland's book as he begins by telling us about his encounter with a black bear and calls it a typical UP experience. But for those who don't mind bears, black flies, aandy quagmires, bumpy trails and steep hills, this is the book to guide you to Michigan's most beautiful spots. All of these things are described with good humer by McLelland, eware that mountain bikers clisis discomfort. (And there are many trails that have none of those drawbacks and are great

places for families to venture into the "wild.")
For the less wild side of Michigan, Susan Newhof offers the new 4th Edition of "Michigan's Town & Country Inns. This is the lifet update in 10 years and features several new inns and bed and breakfast facilities from Pysilanti to Houghton. Newhof has selected 30 inns from the many in the state, concentrating on those with five or more rooms, though she has retained some smaller B&Bs from her previous editions. She also explains the proper protocol of staying at a B&Bs.

Newhof's approach is anecdotal, giving us a history of the house and its town and the innkcepers, who, as she points out, are a vital element in all B&Bs. She describes the accommodations and the food and concludes with a "vitale" list outlining things you should know, such as price and how many rooms have private baths, and aphone number. A general state map is provided, but for detailed directions you have to speak to the innkceper, which is good as Newhof advises making; receivations whenever you want to stay at a B&B.
