

POLICE AND FIRE CALLS

The following are police and fire incidents that occurred in Farmington and Farmington Hills during the past week.

STOLEN TRUCK RECOVERED

In Farmington Hills: Police arrested a Macon, Ga., man, 60, after finding a stolen 1991 Ford Explorer parked at the Park Motel on Grand River Avenue May 31. A man told police a friend gave him the truck at a truck driving school in Indiana. As agreed, he drove the truck to Georgia for a woman to pick up. He said he couldn't find the woman or her address. Police found the woman's name, address and phone number in the center console along with a work order that indicated the man is intending to stay in Michigan.

BAR MANAGER ATTACKED

In Farmington Hills: The night manager at Shots Tavern on 10 Mile Road told police she was attacked by two women after she closed the bar at 2:25 a.m. June 1. Her attackers grabbed her from behind when she managed to kick one of them in the stomach. The pair fled after she used pepper spray against them. The woman believes the pair may be two females she booted from the bar at 8 p.m. for not having valid identification.

THREATS
