Botsford couple pilots innovative cardiac center

Dr. T. Barry Levine reviews his most recent notes on MACH I. Preparing for an upcoming international conference in Vienna at which he will address his research team's findings, Levine beams with excitement. Working on projects with names like MACH I, you'd think Levine was an astronaut and knew all about the speed of sound. Not true. In fact, the only speed this dector cares about has to do with heart rates.

Levine, the director of the Michigan Institute for Heart Failure and Transplant Care at Botsford General Hospital in Farmington Hills, is charged with overseeing MACH I, which stands for Mortality Assessment in Congestive Heart Failure.
