Dagwood's Deli (33179 Grand River Ave.) specializes in sandwiches galore.Popular, freshly-made, high-stacked con-coctions draw folks every day except Sunday when the shop is closed.

A good ol' fish fry makes a splash at Cowley's Old Village Inn (33338 Grand River Ave.) every Friday night, while salmon patties get rave reviews on the third Friday of every month. The-Irish pub is also known for its live weekend Irish music and beer selection. New management promises some fun changes, including menu, beverage and "ill around" makeover.
