Presbyterian 'Misson' Workers In Detroit Area

Six United Presbyterian overseas workers have come to Detroit for four months to engage in the "Response to Crisis" program of the denomination.

The team, under the sponsorship of the Presbytery of Detroit, will assist local churches and individuals in responding to an affirmative manner to the crisis in our communities and world.

"This group is here to share the Christian faith, increase our understanding of its implications for our time, and unite our following as Christians," Dr. Robert H. Yellon, executive of the presbytery, stated.

THE REV. DONALD R. JAFFE, pastor of Keweenaw Park Presbyterian Church, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, who has been given a leave of absence by his congregation, is the coordinator of the program, which will continue through Dec. 15. The project is the result of action taken by the General Assembly of the church at its meeting in Minneapolis in May, to redeploy 75 missionaries and national to the United States. Work was begun in June in Chicago, Washington, D.C., Tampa, and St. Petersburg.

Churches In U.S. Fly Tons Of Food To Biafra

Officials of American Protestant and Catholic overseas aid agencies have announced that during the month of September and the first week of October over 2,800 tons of food and medicines were flown into the blockaded former eastern region of Nigeria.
