## Trustees Approve Purchases

Equipment purchases totaling \$46,350.75 have been approved by the Farmington Board of Education.

In addition to buying equipment for three different schools and maintenance tractors, the Board approved spending \$2,700 to relocate three classroom units at the Middlebelt School.

The units will be moved to the Highmound School. Purchases for North Farmington High's addition will include audio visual equipment and musical instruments for the band. Total cost of all the North Farmington purchases is \$18,040.95.

Power Junior High received \$2,753.59 worth of equipment including sheet music, goal posts for the physical education field and industrial arts equipment.

A total of \$19,239.21 in purchases were approved for the Farmington High School addition. Furniture, choral risers, audio visual equipment, library materials, material for the language lab, office machines, a basketball scoreboard and maintenance and custodial equipment were all included in the purchase.

The tractors for the maintenance department cost a total of \$6,327.00.

All of the funds will be paid for out of the building and site funds of the district.

The question on whether or not the moving of the portable classrooms can be paid for out

of these funds will be decided by the school's auditor. If this is not possible the \$2,700 will come out of the district's general funds.

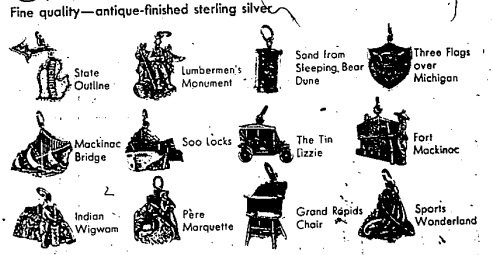
