# Redford Music Fare 'Another Mozart'

Area classical music lovers will have a chance to hear for themselves on Nov. 16 why Australia's 12-year-old Rita Richman is being acclaimed by music critics as "another Mozart."

The child prodigy will make her American debut in concert with the Redford Township symphony orchestra, sponsored by the Redford Township Music Society. Conducting will be John Gajec.

The Nov. 16 concert will begin at 8 p.m. in Thurston High School on Schoolcraft Road in Redford Township.

Ticket sale is limited to 1,000. Tickets are \$9 for adults and \$1.50 for children under 12. They may be ordered from Mrs. John Karul (532-4040) or Mrs. Robert Zimmerman (535-4119).

NICKNAMED "Melbourne's Miss Mozart" for her unusual talents as pianist-composer, Rita will play some of the more advanced and difficult compositions of Mozart, Mendelssohn, and Beethoven, Schumann and Haydn as well as three of the 75 works she has composed.

In the first half of the concert she will be accompanied by the orchestra in Mendelssohn's "Capriccio Brillante in B minor."

The second half will be devoted to Haydn's "Sonata in D major; Schumann's "Scenes of Childhood"; Beethoven's "Ronde in C"; Mendelssohn's "Songs Without Words" and Mozart's "Fantasia in D minor."

In the latter half of the concert, she will play three of her

own compositions, including her latest, "Luna Park Suite." Written in seven movements, it was completed this year. The other two original works are "Appassionata," written in 1966, and "Water Fairies," composed in 1965.

BORN IN Melbourne into a musical family, Rita is said to have elicited her tongue like a virtuoso in time to the music of her brother, David, and sister, Shirley, practiced together.

At 2 1/2, she could play everything she heard by ear, including a movement from a Beethoven sonata.

She began formal music lessons at the age of three and could read music in four weeks, although she did not know the alphabet. She was given a full music scholarship from Pianist Jascha Spivakovsky, who described her as a "brilliant musical prodigy." He also discovered she had perfect pitch.

AT THE AGE of four, Rita began studying theory and composition on a scholarship with one of Melbourne's leading composers and critics, Felix Warden, who reportedly marveled at her understanding of musical composition.

Soon after, she won first prize for composition at a yearly music festival. That same year she performed for the concert pianist, Manfred Clynes, who wanted to recommend her for a full scholarship at Juillard School of Music in New York. But her mother declined the offer, stating Rita was too young to leave the family.

Just before leaving Australia, Rita was preparing to play with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra—but the move to Interlochen changed her plans. But she's getting her wish to be soloist with a symphony after all—only the locale will be Redford Township.

RITA AND HER family are being sponsored at Interlochen by the W. Clement and Jessie V. Stone Foundation. Mrs. Reichman, an accomplished linguist, is a language teacher at Interlochen's Arts Academy. So far the Reichmans haven't

made up their mind where Rita will continue her studies.

But if you ask Rita she'll more fun." And having fun is life as it is with any 12-year-old. pick Interlochen "because it's just as much a part of Rita's old.
