## Record falls at fourth annual Just Zoo It!

One new record was established — and an existing mark came within one second of being tied — at the fourth annual Just Zoo It! five-kilometer run.

The race, conducted last Saturday at the Detroit Zoo in conjunction with the Just Zoo It! event to raise public awareness about organ donation issues, featured an exciting finish as Guy Murray of Farmington Hills edged Bedford's Paul Aufderberg by one second for the overall title.

Murray, crowned the 1998 Big Boy Road Series overall winner earlier this month, clocked a time of 14 minutes, 57 seconds.

University of Michigan runner Ian Forsyth still holds the race record of 14:56 set in 1996.

The women's race, on the other hand, generated a record-setting performance. Teresa Dack of Windsor, Ontario, Canada, crossed in 17:04, breaking Jodi Buck's previous standard of 17:41 posted last year.
