WHEN ARTHRITIS RUNS IN THE FAMILY

When arthritis runs in the family, what is your risk? At this time, your physician cannot give you an answer. In part the reason is because an understanding of the different forms of arthritis was poorly understood in the past. Much arthritis was called "rheumatism" a term that indicates a joint and or muscle condition, but doesn't say which one. In the past arthritis was often misdiagnosed, with confusion between rheumatoid, osteoarthritis, gouty arthritis, and psoriatic arthritis. This family history in this area is suspect today. Another source of difficulty in predicting if you will exhibit a family trait of arthritis is complexity in the pattern of heredity in arthritis. Studies of rheumatoid arthritis, ankylosing spondylitis, and osteoarthritis indicated that there is a tendency to transmit these conditions from generation to generation. However, the genetic code that brings on a susceptibility for arthritis is often incompletely expressed. The reason for this incomplete report of arthritis genes is not understood. Your physician has no way at present to undertake a chromosome analysis or other blood test that would indicate you are likely to show a familial arthritis trait. Keep compiling such family information. It will benefit your children. The day will come when knowledge of the condition you are prone to, will be the basis for prevention of the arthritis itself.
