

POLICE AND FIRE CALLS

The following are police and fire incidents that occurred in Farmington and Farmington Hills during the past week.

**THEFTS**  
**In Farmington Hills:** Someone stole \$400 worth of patio furniture from a Wilton residence Aug. 5.  
Someone stole an American Tourister suitcase as well as a CD stereo, 50 CDs and two change jars with \$50 inside from a Greenhill Apartment residence Aug. 6.

**BURGLARY**  
**In Farmington Hills:** A member of a cleaning crew saw a man holding a fax machine and a box at Woodbridge Homes on Orchard Lake around 8 p.m. Aug. 5. The woman noticed the office doors had been kicked open and she phoned police. She witnessed the man carrying the equipment and put it into a Lincoln Navigator before driving away. Police found the desk drawers opened and ransacked. A file cabinet had been moved, which allowed the burglar to crawl through the ceiling and into another office. The man is described as black, 6-foot-3 inches tall, wearing black pants, white shirt and red high-top tennis shoes.

**DRUNKEN DRIVING**  
**In Farmington Hills:** Police arrested a Livonia man, 27, after the 1997 Pontiac Sunbird he was driving was involved in an accident on Halsted and 11 Mile Roads shortly after midnight Aug. 7. The driver was bleeding from the forehead. The driver had a blood alcohol level of 0.16 percent at the scene.

Police arrested a Livonia man, 28, for drunken driving after the 1997 Ford Explorer he was driving crashed into a utility pole on 12 Mile near Oldfield early morning Aug. 8. The driver had a blood alcohol level of 0.12 percent. It is illegal to drive in Michigan with a level of 0.10 percent or higher.

**In Farmington:** A 72-year-old Detroit man was arrested for drunken driving at approximately 1:15 a.m. Friday, near Grand River-Hawthorne. An officer observed the man walking around vehicles parked outside the Rustic Pub, looking for his car. The man then drove "very slowly" before being stopped. His blood alcohol level was 0.128 percent.

Police arrested a 60-year-old Detroit man for drunken driving about 1:20 a.m. Thursday. He was stopped on Grand River at School after being observed driving through an intersection. His blood alcohol level was 0.221 percent.

**OPEN INTOXICANTS**  
**In Farmington:** Officers stopped a vehicle speeding on Grand River at Power 1:20 a.m. Thursday. The odor of intoxicants was noticed on the breath of one of the vehicle's two occupants. A plastic cup, half-filled with an alcoholic beverage, was in plain view on the front console. The passenger, a 24-year-old Farmington Hills man, admitted to drinking the booze. He was ticketed for consuming open intoxicants in a motor vehicle and faces a hearing in 47th District Court.

**VANDALISM**  
**In Farmington Hills:** Someone used an M-80 firecracker to blow up a mailbox on Kendallwood around 11 p.m. Aug. 5. The resident heard a loud noise and saw a car speeding away. A mailbox was destroyed - possibly by an M-80 - on Thornycroft Road shortly after 11 p.m. Aug. 6.

A sharp-edged vandal slashed the tires on a 1998 Toyota parked at Extended Stay on Slansbury between July 1-Aug. 6, causing \$200 damage.

**LOOSE 'N' BULL**  
**In Farmington Hills:** Police responded to the report of a pit bull running loose through a Power Road neighborhood around 7:15 p.m. Aug. 6. A neighbor said the dog has been terrorizing his family, including his young child. When police asked the owner to call in his pet, he said, "Why? He's not hurting no one." The owner did call the dog back inside the house, but it escaped out the door. Police snared the animal and took the dog to the department. At the station, officers had a difficult time getting the animal out of the back seat of the

patrol car. The dog continued to growl and snap at officers before they were able to get him inside a pen. Police have been to dog owner's home five times since June 23 and have ticketed him three times for failing to control his pet.

**STOLEN CAR FOUND**  
**In Farmington:** It was reported Wednesday that a car was stolen from a business parking lot in the 22000 block of Farmington Road. The following day, Detroit police called to report the vehicle and suspect were found at Pompano and Tracy. The owner of the \$6,000 vehicle was subse-

quently contacted and said he did not know the suspect.

**SUSPICIOUS PERSON**  
**In Farmington:** At about 10 p.m. Tuesday, a 25-year-old female bartender at Rustic Pub, 31030 Grand River, contacted police about a man sitting at the bar with his zipper down and penis exposed. The 37-year-old Redford man told police he had just been to the bathroom, and might have had his zipper down, but that he did not expose himself. The woman said she did not wish to file a complaint. The man was told to leave and not return, or else face charges for trespassing.
