"Digital imaging," said Valenti, "is the electronic capture, storage and outputting of images."

This newspaper has a mixed system. We scan existing negatives or photos and store them, digitally. Then we compose pages on a computer screen. No longer do we cut and pasto paper copies of stories, headlines, photos and adds onto paper forms.

But we still print on presses that reduce photos to dots. Look closely at any black and white picture in this paper, and you will see that there are no true gray tones. What you're seeing story tiny dots – large where the tone is ight. The many shades of gray are an optical illusion.

In fully digital graphics, however, you are seeing a checker-board or grid with tiny squares enlled pixels, 72 to the inch. Each pixel has its own color, Valenti explained. Gray and pink really are gray and pink, not small dots of black and small date of fred.

The advantage of digital photography is that its reproduction is truer, and the graphic artist can use a computer to blend—or even manipulate—several photography into a single graphic. Speed is another blessing of the new technology. Photographors (and their subjects) can review their work immediately on a computer or in the camera—there is no film to process. film to process.
Digital imaging's use in the

movies is becoming legendary.
Corporate annual and internal
reports often are digitally produced. "Even student term
papers aren't written on the old
Smith Corona any moro," Valenti said.

"Look at the growth in Webpages on the Internet. You'd have to digitize to use pictures on your Webpage."

In the same way Valenti had to retrain to move from photography to digital imaging, many OCC students are workers who are retraining. "They're coming from GM, Ford and Americehete Yellow Pages are laid out electronically now," he said.

Several years ago, OCC started with non-credit digital courses which required just seven computer work stations. Now the lab in D Bullding has 24 stations for credit courses. Keth said sections fill up quickly during registration.

"At first there were only two sections. The classes were filling, and we had a waiting list of 100 to get in," Valenti said. Even when classes are being taught, some work stations are left open so students from other sections on work.

At OCC, photography is taught on the Royal Oak and Orchard Ridge campuses. Valentit teaches the digital classes of Orchard Ridge. Other photography instructors are Mike Cyru, who has an "outstanding faculty" award and two degrees from Eastern Michigan; and Rob Kangas, who also has an "outstand-

ing faculty award and degrees from the Center for Creative Studies and the University of Michigan.

At OCC, getting an associate's degree in photography involves more than picture taking and printing. The cataleg lists courses in black-and-white, color, list-cory of photography, studie work (including fashion and architecture), special projects and Vaient's three courses in digital photography.


