

Zald also bettered his state-cut time in the 50 freestyle and took over first place in the Observer-land rankings with a winning time of 22.30. In all, North had 36 individual best times.
Farber qualified for state in the breaststroke (1:02.68) and also improved his time by more than two seconds in the butterfly (56.59). Both wore first-place swims.


