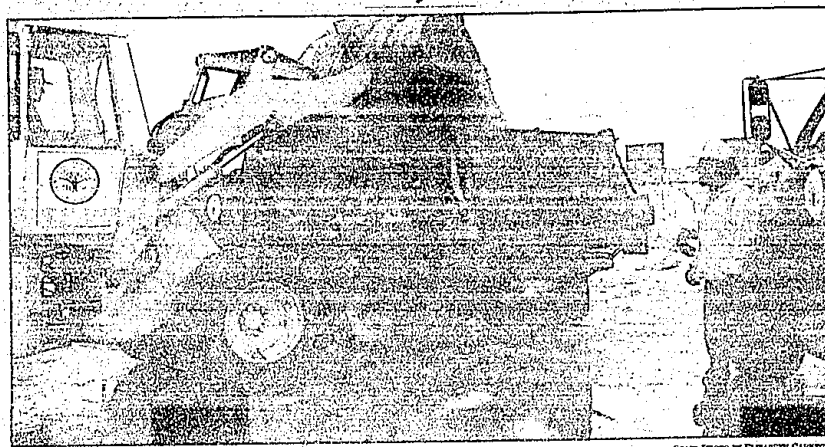

Running stop sign leads to man's arrest

HILLS POLICE

Police arrested a Livonia man, 19, for possession of a police scanner, but he's suspected of coping more than an attitude.

On March 7, Hills police stopped the 1986 Olds Cutlass after it ran a stop sign in the Drake-M-5 area. The driver said he was using his cellular phone and didn't see the sign.

Inside the car, officers found a Mag-Lite flashlight, scanner, handcuffs and blue spotlight. Hills police were informed a Bonaventure Skating Rink employee had his car outfitted with a siren and police lights. He also had reportedly been stopping people.

'We haven't been able to uncover a legitimate reason as

to why he had all those items,' Assistant Chief Chuck Nebus said. The driver told the officer he's a disc jockey at the rink, but is asked to 'control the kids' every so often. He said he uses the cuffs if needed.

Police activated the scanner, which was tuned into the Farmington Hills, Southfield and Redford police. The officer then turned on the three channel siren and flashing hi-lo headlights.

The driver said he used the car to intimidate the kids at Bonaventure to think the police were there, so they would go back up front.
