Complimenting and Praising Others

William James, the American philosopher and psychologist once said that "all the people really want is to be praised." And, I would like to add, that it doesn't cost a thing to praise other people or to say something to them about their good qualities. I guess it is a human nature that most people enjoy being complimented and praised. Whenever we give honest praise to someone, especially someone who generally does not receive many compliments, it helps to build self-esteem, and may actually make him or her strive to be a better person.
