## Detective work uncovers rare syndrome

Parsonage-Turner Syndrome - What is it? You or someone you know may have it or have experienced it in the past and physicians were not able to correctly diagnose it. Why?

The medical dictionary at Botsford Hospital describes it this way: "neuralgic amytrophy, a brachial plexus disorder characterized by sudden pain and muscle weakness in the upper limbs and possible muscular wnating or atrophy. The cause is unknown."

I think it's important to further define some of these terms. Neuralgic refers to a nerve or pain in a nerve. Amytrophy basically means atrophy, or wasting away. Brachial refers to the arm. Plexus refers to a network of blood vessels and nerve fibers.

I know about this syndrome because I have what is still exists after a hand operation in December 1994. Any number of physicians over the years were either unwilling or unable to diagnose my condition. Some doctors are thought to be unwilling to tell a patient what they may have due to their fear of litigation. But I've been on the trail of finding a diagnosis and cause of my prob-




