phone to call for help, the employee saw a male with a dark-hooded shirt riding a mountain bike. "It could be just a coincidence or it could'se bean the perpetra-tor," Nobus said. Another employee kid behind a dumpster and removed her workshirt, afraid the robber was still in the store, police reports said.


