made it 7-0. Weber, who finished the game with 71 yards rushing and 83 yards through the air, was 3-for-3 passing during the drive.

"Grant played his tail off tonight," Bechtel said. "We didn't get him out on the perimeter as much as we would have liked, but considering it was only the second game he's played at quarterback I thought he played extremely well."

The Falcons' defense made sure the momentum stayed on their side of the field by holding the Chiefs to three non-productive runs and a punt on their next series.

Taking over at their 29-yard line, the Falcons engineered an impressive, nine-play, 71-yard

scoring drive.

Senior Mike Addison punctuated the drive when he took a pitch from Weber at the Chiefs' 12-yard line, cut back toward the middle of the field and eluded two Chiefs at the goal line to score the Falcons' second touchdown. Wayne's second PAT increased the lead to 14-0.

The drive was kept alive by a fourth-down offense penalty against the Chiefs.

With two seconds left in the first half, Weber reached paydirt for the second time when he snuck it over from the 1. A botched snap on the extra point left the score at 20-0.

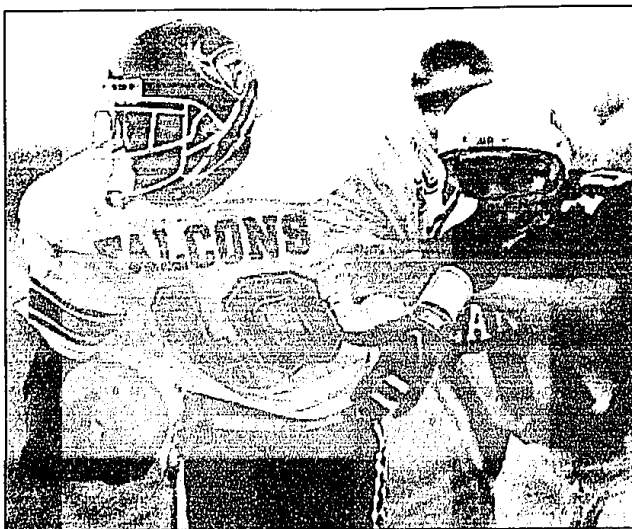
Farmington didn't waste any time proving that its first-half performance was no fluke.

The Falcons took the second-half kickoff and efficiently marched 67 yards, scoring on a 6-yard run by junior fullback Dave Peterson. Wayne's extra point finished the game's scoring.

Canton threatened early in the fourth quarter when, on a fourth-down play, junior quarterback Oliver Wolcott hooked up with wide receiver Ian Riley on a 51-yard pass play that took the ball to the Falcons' 7.

However, two short runs and two incomplete passes later, the Falcons' impressive defense held again.

"I'm disappointed," Baechler said, "but we'll be right back out there tomorrow working hard to get ready for our next game."

## Warriors rally to beat winless Rocks

The Rocks scored first. And that was it.

On Friday at Walled Lake Western, Plymouth Salem's offense stalled by the middle of the first quarter and could never get restarted as the Warriors pulled out a 17-3 triumph in a Western Lakes Activities Association crossover football game.

The loss left Salem at 0-2. Western, one of the favorites to win the WLAA, is 2-0.

The win didn't come easily for the Warriors. Salem used a 49-

yard return of the opening kickoff by Andy Koczkowski to start its first possession in Western territory, at the 42-yard line. Quarterback Matt Fair ran 21 yards on the first play, and Salem pushed inside the 10 before the drive stalled. Fair booted a 20-yard field goal.

On the Rocks next possession, Fair and Jason Purr hooked up on a 60-yard pass play to the Western 30. That was the high point in the game for Salem.

Western tied it at 3-3 on a 30-

yard field goal by Alan Mukter with 11 seconds left in the half. It stayed that way until the fourth quarter; the Warriors finally broke it open when Cody Cargill raced 60 yards for a touchdown with 10 minutes left to play, giving them a 9-3 lead.

The clincher came with 1:33 left. Chris Payton went 11 yards into the end zone for the TD and passed for the two points.

Cargill gained 187 yards on 20 attempts, and Payton had another 60 on 10 tries.

Ryan Lukas had six tackles each. Sophomore Aaron Kennedy caused the fumble that led to Menotti's touchdown.

**NORTHVILLE 45, N. FARMINGTON 14:** Senior Brian Luter scored for the visiting Raiders on a 50-yard pass from junior Blair Weiss, and senior Todd Weiss had a 12-run touchdown run late in the game Friday.

Luter's touchdown and two-point conversion run capped a North drive early in the third quarter and cut the Northville lead to 21-8.

But the Mustangs countered with a field goal on their next possession and followed that with a touchdown for a 31-8 advantage.

"We turned the ball over way too much," North coach Rich Burrell said. The Raiders had six passes intercepted and lost three fumbles. "You can't win football games like that."

Northville dominated the line of scrimmage. Their front five on both sides of the ball beat us up."

Burrell estimated the Mustangs outweighed the Raiders by 50 to 70 pounds per man on the line.

"They had tremendous pressure up the middle, and our quarterback didn't have time to throw," he said. "That's

what led to the interceptions.

"We fought hard for three quarters. I thought we played pretty well, considering we were outplayed. The effort was there."

Both teams are 1-1 overall. **CLARENCEVILLE 37, NORTHWEST 34:** The Trojans are unbeaten, but Coach Greg Hudkins thinks they're skirting the line.

What's to be bothered by when your tailback, sophomore Tim Shaw in this case, scores 19 times and gains 194 yards with four touchdowns?

"We controlled the ball," Hudkins said. "And our kids did a nice job. But we were kind of disciplined at times and then we were sloppy."

"We had something like 11 penalties to their two, and I'm not really happy about that. You can be sure we'll be working on that this week."

Shaw scored his touchdowns from distances of 1, 69, 23 and 3 yards as Clarenceville, bidding for its second straight trip to the playoffs, took leads of 12-0 and 20-6 after the first two quarters.

Junior wingback Scott Wion ran the host Rochester Hills Lutheran Northwest, and quarterback Tim Reid completed half his six passes for 42 yards.

Reid also completed a two-point conversion pass after the Trojans were penalized, tossing it to tight end Kevin Siye.

Kalen McPherson and Brent Kerrigan stood out on defense for Clarenceville, now 2-0.

"We told our kids you either get better or get worse every week," Hudkins said. "And we admitted we got worse. We vowed we were going to make sure it didn't happen again."

**GARDEN CITY 18, ALLEN PARK 14:** A year ago, Garden City's football team won two games. The Cougars matched that total Friday.

And not against some slouch. Two second-half touchdowns by Mike Sparks, the second coming with just 1:14 left to play, carried Garden City to a home-field win over Allen Park (1-1). With 1:05 left in the third, Sparks scored on a 15-yard TD run, making it 14-13. But the extra-point kick was missed, leaving Garden City trailing by a point. That deficit was overcome thanks to a couple of key plays.

The first was delivered by Alan Marzalek, who picked off a Bobby Marten pass and returned it to the Allen Park 30. Two plays later, Sparks got loose on a 29-yard touchdown run — and the Cougars had their upset win.
