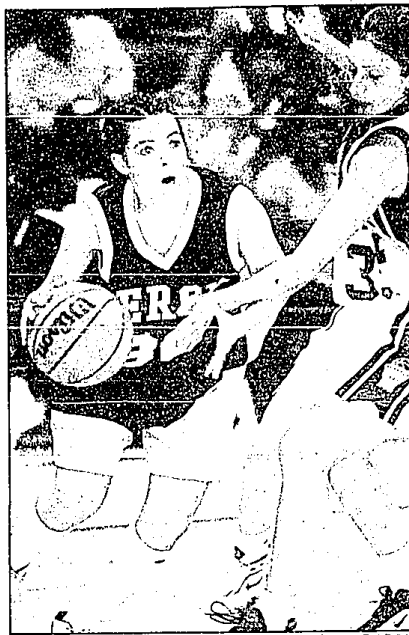

BASKETBALL

HARRISON 66, DEARBORN 30: Four players scored in double figures for the Hawks (5-3), who won their fourth consecutive game Monday at Dearborn.

All Ault and Kelly Taylor scored 15 points apiece, Emily Jackson 12 and Ari Ault 10. Cierra Colbert and Becky Zak had four rebounds each.

The Hawks jumped to a 21-4 lead in the first quarter and coasted into halftime with a 39-13 lead.
