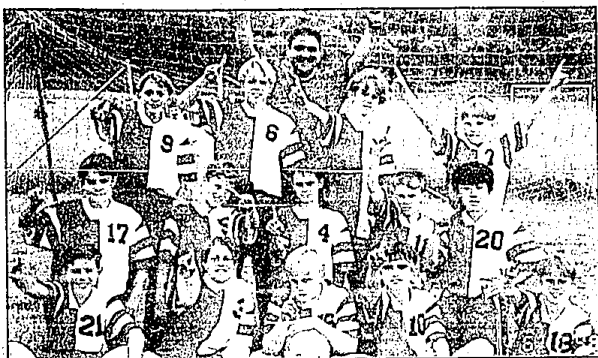


Soccer champions

PREP HOCKEY TRYOUTS

SOCCER TEAM UNBEATEN

Madonna University's men's soccer team finished an unbeaten league season Wednesday by knocking off Spring Arbor in a Wolverine-Hoosier Athletic Conference game, 5-0.

The host Crusaders got goals from five different players including the 19th of the season by Steve Emert, who now

has a school record 46 in his career.

Madonna is now 17-1 overall and unbeaten in 14 WHAC games. It will host a second-round WHAC playoff game on Thursday.

Vic Rodopoulos, assisted by freshman Sam Piraine, got Madonna's first goal and James Catlett scored off a free kick with 15 minutes left in the first half to make it 2-0 at halftime.

Emert scored one minute into the second half, assisted by Piraine, and then assisted on goals by Tim Blevins and Piraine to round out the scoring.

FALL SKATING CLASSES

Suburban Hockey Schools kicks off its fall and winter class schedule with three programs for kids and adults at the Suburban Training Center in Farmington Hills.

A sunrise power skate takes place 6:45-7:35 a.m. on Fridays. An advanced power skate is scheduled for 3:30-4:20 p.m. Fridays.

Elizabeth Posvar achieved a state cut in the 100-yard breaststroke Thursday with a winning time of 1:11.08 in Farmington Hills Mercy's 119-67 victory over host Novi.

Posvar also won the individual medley (2:13.02) and helped the Marlins win two relays.

Kelly Carlin won two events and was the top winning relay team. She was first in the 200 freestyle (1:55.51) and the 100 freestyle (55.89).

Posvar led off and Carlin anchored the 200 freestyle relay. Elizabeth MacDonald and Kristin Loidas swam the second and third legs, and the Marlins finished in 1:43.47.

Carlin was the lead swimmer on the 400 freestyle team. Loidas, MacDonald and Amy McCullough followed her as

Mercy posted a 3:47.83 time. McCullough, Posvar, Erin Downs and Katie Matous combined to win the medley relay (1:56.09).

Loidas also won the 50 freestyle (26.12). MacDonald the butterfly (1:05.21). McCullough the 500 freestyle (5:10.26) and Downs the backstroke (1:04.58).

The Marlins will next attempt to repeat as Catholic League champs Saturday, Nov. 14, at Royal Oak Dondoro High School.

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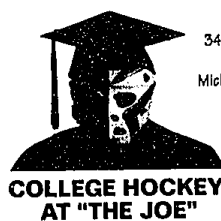
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
