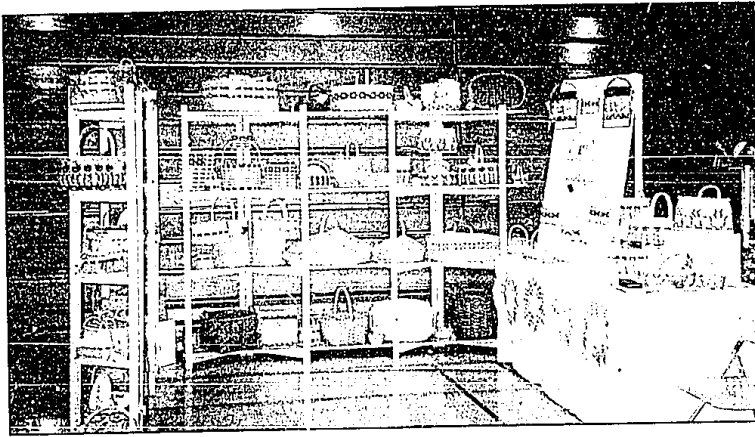

POLICE AND FIRE NEWS

The following are police and fire incidents that occurred in Farmington and Farmington Hills during the past week.

MARIJUANA POSSESSION

In Farmington Hills: Police arrested a Livonia man, 21, after finding 3 grams of marijuana and rolling papers in the 1989 Dodge Colt he was driving Nov. 6.

In Farmington Hills: A \$33,000 Toyota Four Runner turned up in the driveway of a Bob Saks Toyota employee, who was fired Nov. 4.

A part-time salesman who recruits customers for Bob Saks is believed to have stolen a 1997 Chrysler Sebring from the dealer Aug. 13. A woman said she talked to the salesman about buying the car but decided against it when she couldn't afford it. She said the salesman told her she was liable. Later, she received a payment book and the car's title in the mail. Saks contacted the salesman, who admitted taking the vehicle. He has not brought it back. He got insurance through the woman's name.

ARSON

In Farmington Hills:

Police are investigating after they found a pile of burned newspapers on the floor of a Waldron Street home Nov. 6. The fire burned one foot of the wall in the home, which was described as unlivable by police.

BREAK-INS

In Farmington Hills:

Someone picked the lock on a 1992 Ford Escort and stole a cellular phone, 25 CDs and a Sony FM/AM stereo while the car was parked on Ontaga Street Nov. 6.
