



On nearly half of the medical runs, trained paramedies give advanced life support care to patients. Through radio contact with emergency room dectors, the paramedies start IVs, defibrillation or other critical care needed. needed.
"We're extending the care you'd receive in

"We're extending the care you'd receive in the emergency department to your home or shopping mall where we respond on medical runs," Bersche said.

The department set July 1997 as the tar-get date, Bersche had ALS up and running three months earlier.

In the time preceding the switchover, his

work week ranged 50 to 75 hours. His wife, Terri, and two children Benjamin, 12, and Jill, 10, didn't see much of bim.

He reworked schedules so trained paramedies would be available on every run.

To fill the gap, he allas started a second paramedie training class. The department now has 41 trained paramedies, who handle an average of 37 Advanced Life Support emergencies a week.

He established a relationship with Bots-ford Hospital's Emergency Department, which receives 67 percent of the medical runs. Other patients are taken to Provi-dence, William Beaumont, St. Mary and


Bersche worked for Young's Environmental for two years – handling everything from chemical spills to explosive materials before Marinucci summoned him back.
