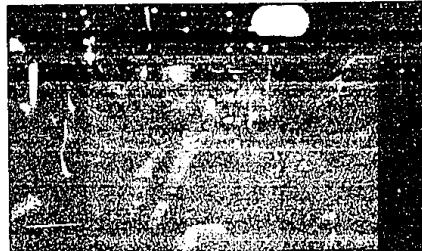
**THE WHOLE NEW VAZOS**
