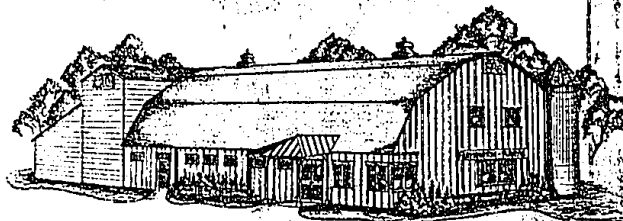

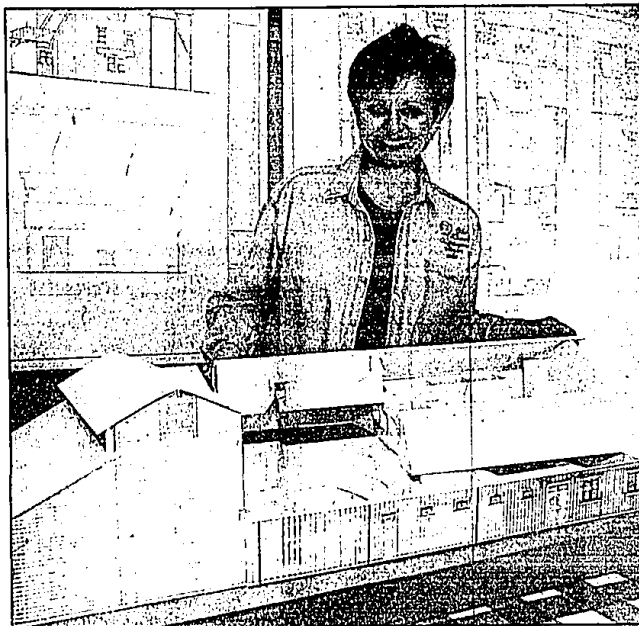
Kiss Me Kate, it will be no more, and the Players want to do something to commemorate the occasion.
