The Napoleonic wars had broken up the established power structure in Europe. Denmark, which had dominated Norway for more than 400 years, was forced in 1814 to cede Norway to Sweden, like a piece of Danish property, Outraged Norwegian leaders quickly called a constituent assembly. The assembly took one menth to produce the

constitution, enabling Norway to enter the new union with Sweden as an equal partner. When that union was dissolved in 1905, the constitution became the foundation of the country which today has one of the highest standards of living in the world.
