**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that three public hearings shall be held before the City Council of the City of Farmington Hills on the adoption of three Brownfield Redevelopment Plans for property in the City of Farmington Hills. The public hearings are being held pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of the Brownfield Redevelopment Financing Act, being Act 381 of the Public Acts of the State of Michigan of 1996, as amended.

These plans include information concerning the environmental conditions of the properties and actions to be taken to address these conditions in connection with proposed redevelopment projects. The ultimate land use of these properties will be considered by the Planning Commission and City Council at subsequent public hearings and is not the subject of the Brownfield Redevelopment Plans.

The public hearings will include properties at the following locations:

**PLAN 1 -** Eleven Plains San Marino Development: West of Halsted Road and south of Eleven Mile Road and east of Halsted Road and north of Eleven Mile Road, and

**PLAN 2a -** Walden Drive Development: the northeast corner of Grand River Avenue and Eight Mile Road, and

**PLAN 2b -** Neighborhood Shopping Center: the northeast corner of Grand River Avenue and Walden.

Map, plans and a description of the Brownfield Plans are available for public inspection at the City Manager's Office, 31555 W. Eleven Mile Road, Farmington Hills, Michigan. All aspects of the Brownfield Redevelopment Plans are open for discussion at the public hearings.
