Marlins win 4th meet in row

Farmington Hills Mercy continues to excel on the ski slopes. The Marlins came out of Tuesday's girls giant slalom at Mount Brighton with a 36-40 victory over Brighton. Okemos was third, another 10 points back.

Detroit Catholic Central was edged out, 38-42, by Okemos, in the boys giant slalom. Brighton was third with 71 points.

The Mercy and CC squads are coached by Tom Gable. Mercy's top four skiers were in the top 14 with freshman Liz Kujala and Nikki Anderson finishing fourth and fifth.

Kujala made her first run in 16.95 and the second in 14.87 for a 30.82 combined time. Anderson's runs were 16.53 and 14.49.

Laura Burek was 13th with a time of 32.90 on runs of 17.37 and 16.53, while Nicole Zaleski was 14th, turning in times of 17.68 and 15.69.

Mercy Godlew took 21st with a 35.24 combined time. Melissa Desautel was disqualified on her second run.

PREP SKIING

Matt Gable took first place overall to lead three CC skiers in the top 10. His combined time of 25.87 was achieved on runs of 11.86 and 14.01. He was almost a full second faster on his first run than the runner-up.

Eric Sullivan recorded runs of 13.10 and 15.16 to finish eighth with a combined clocking of 28.26. John Gabel was 10th, turning in runs of 13.12 and 15.36, while Ryan Boudreau finished 23rd at 30.78 on runs of 13.92 and 16.86.

Joe Murray was 29th with a combined time of 31.45, and Che Martinez rounded out the Shamrock squad with a 50th-place finish at 35.66.

Gable wins CUSSA race

Matt Gable of Livonia won the slalom and finished third in the giant slalom at the Central Unit-

ed States Ski Association Region Ability Race.

Sixty skiers from lower Michigan, Ohio and Indiana, competed last weekend at Boyne Mountain.

Gable, a senior at Redford Catholic Central, completed his first slalom run in 40.48 seconds and the second in 36.78 for a combined time of 1:16.26.

In the giant slalom, Gable finished his first run in 30.48 and the second in 27.50 for a total of 57.98 seconds.

Gable left Wednesday for the four-day Central Mid-America Series, which is by selection only, in Lutsen, Minn.

The Central Region includes Minnesota, Wisconsin, all of Michigan, Missouri, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio and Iowa.

The event, which runs Thursday through Sunday, starts with two giant slaloms at Lutsen and switches to Spirit Mountain for two slaloms.
