Hard to 'Snatch' meaning from Guy Ritchie's latest

Call me the cockeyed optimist.
After reviewing movies for some time now, you'd think I'd learn to take a film's pre-publicity with a bit of salt.
Still, when I read the advance word on Guy Ritchie's Snatch, labeling it a comedy, I was encouraged. As it happened, on labeling it a comedy, I was encouraged. Once the lights dimmed in the theater, I could hardly wait for the picture to start, as a matter of fact. Silly me.

If burnings, hackings, cruelty to animals, shootings, beatings, and other such activities tickle

your funny bone, then Snatch will probably crack you up. You'll probably laugh till you die, actually, since it is full-o-bursting, packed down, and running over with all the above. Otherwise, though scattered moments in this movie may be laughable, many moviegoers will find it about as funny as root canals minus Novocain.

As in Ritchie's debut flick, Lock, Stock, and Two Smoking Barrels, the plot of Snatch is serpentine, to say the least. At its core lurks semething about the heist of an 84-carat diamond. A shifty American (Dennis Farina) and some hoods disguised as rabbis go after it, then a jeweler pretending to be Jewish figures in, then some idiotic pawnshop



owners thicken the morass, along with a boxing "syndicate," and a bunch of Irish gypsies known as "Pikeys." A dog nug-ments the dizzying drama, and

often possesses considerably more charm than many of his thuggish 'superiors.' Stay with me here. Somewhere along the way, somebody rigs a bare-knuckles boxing match or two for three, or four; you lose count), in which Irish gypsy pugilist Mick (Brad Pitt) is instructed to take a fall. Only he won't, because he's just not that kind of guy (or something) and, anyway, the syndicate burned a gypsy caravan in retribution with his sainted mother (Sorcha Cusack) inside it at the time, and Mick is determined that Cusack) inside it at the time, and Mick is determined that they will get theirs. various and sundry, vicious and bloody ways, too. At least, this is pretty much what seems to be happering. You uced a scorecard to keep up, and besides that, American audiences may find much of the English Cockney and Irish gypsy dialogue nearly unintelligible.

On the plus side (and also as in Lock, Stock and Two Smoking Barrels) Ritchie displays a kneckout penchant for cinematic style, and not just in an arresting array of visuals, editing tricks, cuts, freeze framens, slome shots, and over the physical preparance of the cast. This is writerdirector who also understands the importance of sound offects in a film. By the time

Snatch comes to its knockdown, drag-out finish, you may feel pummeled, simply by all the cleverly-placed noise this movie spews forth.

Ritchie also knows something about how to get good performances from his players. Some of those cast in Snatch have never acted before, but, in most cases, it's next to impossible to. Lell that without production notes. A standout is a hefty flow named Ade, whose character-repeatedly fails his task: driving a getaway car.

Dennis Farina as Avi, chief diamond thief, turns in his usual convincing job as a vaguely reptillan villain. And Benicio Dol Toro in the role of Franky Four Fingers definitely makes his mark as a slimy sort you certainly wouldn't want to offend in a dark olley.

Watching Brad Pitt as the tortured and toughened Mick O'Noil, you learn something about movies: It's not necessary to know what an actor is saying all the time in order to know that he's walking away with the show. (Pitt always blends in subtly with the rest of the cast here, though.) This ugly picture may be what has best showcased his subtlents so far, and gone farther than anything else to reveal that he's not just another pretty face.
