## Raiders rise above Phoenix

## SWIMMING

North Farmington won all but one event Thursday to defeat host Farmington-Harrison in boys swimming, 122-63.

Brian Claydon and Sermat Alver were double individual winners for the Raiders — Clayton in the IM and backstroke, Alver in the 50 freestyle and butterfly.

They also helped North win the medley and 400 freestyle relays.

The other winners for the Raiders were Mohamed Bachrouche (200 freestyle), Steve Denton (diving), Jeff Matyska (500 freestyle) and Matt Newman (breaststroke).

"Matyska had his best time in the 500," North coach Pat Duthie said. "Last year he barely made it under six minutes, and now he went 5:32.95 tonight."

"His best time before tonight was 5:44.47, so he's come a long way. He had a great race."

Duthie also cited swimmers Ben Iwry and Newman, who was within a couple hundredths of his best time, in the breaststroke.

Including a win over Walled Lake Western on Tuesday, North won two meets last week without its best swimmer — Adam Farber, who was out with the flu.

The Raiders are 2-1 in the Western Lakes Activities Association and the same overall.

"I'm pleased with what we've done so far," Duthie said. "We're looking better the last couple meets."

"We've been without Adam, but the kids have stepped it up and been willing to do some things. They've been doing a pretty good job. We're starting to look like a swim team."

Mark Benivenga had the lone first place for the Phoenix, who were winless in seven dual meets in the 100 freestyle.

Paul Haapaniemi swam his best times in the 500 freestyle and backstroke Thursday. In recent meets, Colin Hopper had best times in the 500, backstroke and butterfly and Mike Baskie in the breaststroke.

"We're hoping to win the next three meets, and that will help us go into the conference," coach Ross Bandy said. "The team is progressing and we're looking forward to the league meet."
