The result will help replenish blood supplies which were severely diminished by the December snow storms and subsequent holidays.

Among those who made it to the event was Garr's daughter, Melissa, who has become somewhat of a Rad Cross spokeswoman and boster since her near-fatal accident in July 1997. A heavy tree branch outside a community pool fell and struck her on the head, knocking her into a coma.

With the support of the community had blood supplies from the Red Cross, she eventually emerged from the coma and returned to good health. She was able to graduate from Farmington High School and now attends the Oakland Community College-Orchard Ridge campus in Farmington Hills.

Shortly after her accident, a blood drive was hosted by the Hills fire department to come the raid. There were 184 pints collected that day, in September 1997, and that record stood until Thursday.
