Hall of Famer rolls another 300

Livonia resident Mary Mohnesi has bowled another 300 game.

This was the fourth perfect game for the 68-year-old member of the WIBC Hall of Fame.

Mary now ranks as the fifth-oldest woman to get that string of 12 consecutive strikes. She did it Feb. 8, at Cloverlanes in Livonia while competing in the Ten Grand Trio league.

Mohasi was enshrined in the Greater Detroit Bowling Hall of Fame in 1977-78 and has been one of the area's top women bowlers during her career.

She led all Detroit area women bowlers in scoring average for 1984-86, 1977-78 and 1984-86.

She has won numerous national and international events during her career. Mary and son Mark own the 'Right Approach Pro Shop' in Merri Bowl Lanes in Livonia.

•Did you know that Elke can bowl? Certainly the two-legged kind has been bowling for a long time, and now the 81st annual Michigan Elke State Tournament is under way at Cloverlanes in Livonia.

There are about 300 Elks teams entered from around the state as the tournament covers nine weekends ending March 25. After three weeks the Rich Ballard of Ferndale is the current leader in singles actual with 300/780. Other scores include Gerry Gerard, 295/765; George Shay of Troy, 268/741; Geno Grabinaki of Livonia, 289/734. Meanwhile, Ted Stephens and

Dale Manning, both of Waterford, each had a 289 game.

Ballard leads in singles actual and handicap. The event still has a ways to go, so the leader board can change except for high game at the apex with the 300 score.

Moving across to the other side of Cloverlanes, the 72nd annual Lutheran Midwest Tournament is under way.

The competitors come in from all over Michigan, Illinois, Indiana and Ohio. One highlight so far was Bill Mueller, of Novi with a 300 game and his teammate John Koepke of Canton, a 290 score in the same game which has elevated their team to first place.

This event has only one more week to go, so the winners will be reported shortly. •The 8th annual Senior/Youth Challenge took place last Saturday at Mayflower Lanes in Redford.

Opening ceremonies were handled by Jack Dahlstrom, introducing Redford Township supervisor Kevin Kelley, the youngest and oldest bowlers, the tournament committee and another introduction of 87-year-old Jarvis Woehlke, to whom the tournament was dedicated.

After a beautiful singing of the national anthem by Mayflower's own Tammy Pfleghel, Woehlke rolled the ceremonial first ball, which drew plodges of \$10 per pin from Henry Miatelo, Kevin Kelley, Dr. Charles Whalen and Frank Palmieri.

The ball was a perfect strike, a huge success which added \$100 to the scholarship fund. A total of \$5,000 in scholarship funds was awarded to the winning youth bowlers.

Andy Wright helped Ali Harper to third, Storer was fourth with the help of Saad, and Gary Kennan was helped by partner Len Zundel for fifth place (\$500), while Matthew Reif of Redford took sixth (\$250) with help from senior partner Larry Skora.
