The appetizer selection is very appealing, offering anything from calamari, shrimp scampi, and mussels sautéed in a red wine marinara sauce, to a simple plate of marinated eggplant and roasted red peppers. The appetizers also are reasonably priced, from \$5.95 to 36.95 on average.

As expected, there are several pasta choices, ranging from creamy Fettuceine Alfreda to Linguini Pescatore with lots of mussels, scallops and ehrimp, to the very simple Pasta Fagioli, an Italian favorite of spaghetti with a thin tomato sauce, butter beans and black pepper.

Entrées include several veal dishes, riba and sausage, beef, chicken and fish. The Veni Marsala is a top seller, along with the Capellini Amoré.

Chef Tony Yaquinte, Frank's nephew, has a reputation for making delicious soups. "Our beet soup is our chicken pastina.

We make it every day with hesh chicken and carrots, he said.
The cream of mushroom soup I ordered with my grilled eggplant sandwich for lunch one did in thing to tarnish Yaquinto's reputation. It was check full optorinis and portabellas and tasted as good or better than any cream of mushroom soup I've ever had. The porcinis and portabellas "suck up the juice nice," said Chef Yaquinto.
