## Freeman returns in sequel

"Cross is a well-trained, well-educated writer as well as a policeman," Freeman said about his role. "But, his particular strength is he's a mind hunter. It's fun to play because it's more cerebral than activo."

In Along Came a Spider, you'll want to arrive at the theater on time as the movie begins with a bang when Cross loses his partner in the opening sequence during a sting operation that goes

terribly wrong. It's a scene you won't want to miss.


