Hill and Dale Garden Club offers tips

These garden tips come courtesy of the Hill and Dale Garden Club of Farmington, a member of the Federated Garden Clubs of Michigan.

Begin to harden off warmscasson vegetable and flower transplants from cold frame or put flats in sunny, protective areas – but bring them back in at night.

Pansies, azaleas and rhodendrons can be planted. Wait until May 18 to chance begoning and impatiens. If danger of frost, of the Federateu of Michigan.

debris from last year.

■ Use weed and feed now to control future weeds. After the application, you may have to hand pull or spot treat remaining weeds.

■ Houseplants can remain outside during the day, but watch temperatures at night not below 40 degrees. If in doubt, wait until mid-May.

■ If orchids have finished flowering, fertilize regularly with dilute orchid fertilizer with every watering.
