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Harrison remains No. 1 in regional competition

Farmington Harrison won its second straight Division II regional title in boys track and field Friday with a dominating performance in the sprints and relays.

The Hawks scored 123 points and easily outdistanced runner-up Warren Woods-Tower (103), as well as Warren Lincoln and Detroit Renaissance.

"One of our major goals was to win the regional, and we've been pointing toward it all season," Harrison coach John Reed said.

We accomplished a goal, so we're pretty happy.

"We're a school of 1,000 students, and it's hard when we go against teams with 2,000. It's hard to get the depth to win meets but, against the same-size schools, we do pretty well."

The Hawks dominated the 100-meter dash, with Marcus Woods winning the race, Chris Roberson finishing third and Charles Pickett taking fourth.

Terrill Mayberry won the 400 and Agim Shabaji the 200. They combined with Roberson and Woods to win the 800 relay and with Feron Tate and Brian Coats to win the 1,600 relay.

Shabaji, Woods, Pickett and Roberson also comprised the winning 400 relay team.

"We definitely thought we could win those relays," Reed said, "but we were interested to see what Renaissance was like. They were good but not as good as they were last year."

"Our two sprint relays won by large margins, but it was hard because our kids had to run alone. They ran good times, considering nobody was pushing them."

Roberson, who missed the entire football and basketball seasons with a broken ankle, is Harrison's only additional state qualifier. The top two in each event automatically qualify.

"He's quite a comeback story, for a guy who had a steel plate in his ankle to qualify in the 100 and two sprint relays," Reed said.

Kirk Laird was Harrison's only other regional winner in the pole vault. Ramy Sulaiman also qualified in the pole vault, Coats in the 1,600 and Tate in the 800 with second-place finishes.

In non-qualifying relays, Will Piyant scored in the shot put and

high hurdles, Kevin Davis in the 110 and 300 hurdles, Dan Coats in the 3,200, Jarnell Johnson in the long jump and Eric Laschokin in the pole vault.

The state meet will be June 2 at Forest Hills Northern High School in Grand Rapids. The Hawks tied for seventh place last year.

"We're up there in the seedings, so I think we have a chance to score points like we did last year," Reed said. "We'll have to wait and see, but we're planning to go there and do a good job."

"I think the sprint relays will be right up there. We know we can run faster. We haven't had anybody to push us, actually. We have to get in a meet to find out how fast we can go."

DIVISION I REGIONAL: Farmington's 400-meter relay team of Jeremy Mazza, Jawn Spinks, David Peterson and Eric Gaughan was fourth Saturday in the regional at West Bloomfield but was an additional qualifier with a time of 44.10.

Mazza was an additional qualifier with a third-place time of 22.5 in the 200 dash.

North Farmington's Dan Perach and Chris Duncan finished first and second, respectively, in the pole vault and qualified for the state meet June 2 at Rockford.

Harrison won the 3,200- and 400-meter relays but had just two other first places, from Tarrin Dew in the shot put and Julieta Lanna in the pole vault.

The Hawks also were second in eight events, including the 800 and 1,600 relays. The top two finishers in each event, plus any additional qualifiers, advance to the state meet June 2 at Grand Rapids Forest Hills Northern.

Dew was second in the shot put, Shelby Griebek, high jumper, Angela Fodor, 100 hurdles, Laura Lynn, 400 dash, Latoya Burrell, 300 hurdles, and Clara Fletcher, 800 run.

"We thought we could be challenging for some of those firsts," Babcock said. "In the 100 hurdles, Fodor got nosed out by a width of a finger. From where we stood, it looked like it was dead even, but the girl just edged her. We had no complaints; it was a great, great race for Fodor."

Harrison received additional points from Melanie Banks, Debi Hicks, Burrell, Taben Fischer, Krystal Wiles, Christine Metry, Lauren Liebowitz, Rin Hill,

Sarah Sargol and Fodor.

"The balance of events is really what helped us," Babcock said. "We thought we could make a run."

"After Clara got second in the 800, we figured we'd have to go oh-for-the-rest (not to win). I didn't think we'd do that."

"I thought we would come back and run strong in the 3,200 and mile relay. The kids were really up for the meet, and I think their performances really showed it."

A combination of 10 girls helped the Hawks get all four relays to the state meet, including Glynn, who was on three teams.

"That's something we were hoping would happen," Babcock said, "and we ran good times — our best times in all of them."

"Renaissance is the state champion in the 400, so that was a big upset. We knew we had to come up big and do some things right."

DIVISION I REGIONAL: Farmington Hills Mercy was second in the regional at West Bloomfield Saturday, finishing

just three points behind Rochester, 83-80.

Mercy's Judy Telford won the shot put and Anne Rosewater the discus, and Telford was an additional qualifier in the discus.

Whitney Johnson was second in the 300 hurdles but broke her own school record of 47.1, which she set earlier this year, with a 45.4 time. She also qualified in the 100 hurdles.

Alexandra Marshall qualified in the 100, 200 and 400, and she helped the Marlins qualify in the 1,600 relay with a second-place, area-best time of 4:11.4.

Other qualifiers were North Farmington's Kourtney Cummings and Farmington's Courtney James in the pole vault and Susan Barrone of North in the 3,200.

Mercy was third in the Catholic League A-B championship meet today, but Johnson didn't compete due to a pulled quadriceps muscle.

Marshall won the 100, 400 and 200 races and led the Marlins to first place in the 1,600 relay with freshman Carrie Royle substituting for Johnson.

Marshall set a school record in the 400 with a time of 57.8, breaking Nicole Pryor's 1993 record of 58.6. Telford won the discus for the third year in a row, and she also was first in the shot put.

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
