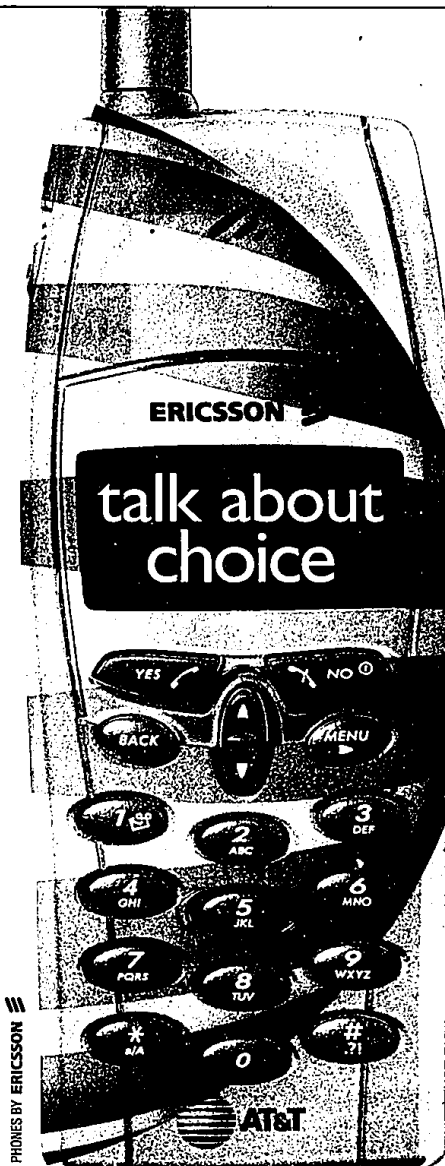
IRENE R. KUBESHEKSKY
