Knives are not part of the tra-ditional Thai place setting – only spoons and forks. Ingredients are processed into very fine pieces as part of their journey to becoming a final dish. Thai peo-ple do not put everything on their plates at once but rather eat from one dish at time edicy-ing each one for its special prop-erties.

What I learned in cooking school in the eity of Chaingmai, located in the northern part of the country, is that things are kept pretty simple in a Thai kitchen. Their basic equipment aream is a teanner, Thai-style wok, food processors mortar and postle which is key for grinding exotic Thail urries. It was amusing and refreshing to see such dramatic results come from such simple means. I found my culinary journey to be intriguing, exotic and exhilarating. The food was fresh, light,

cool, crisp and its warmth was only aurpassed by the very friendly and kindhearted Thai people. What a wonderful life experience – we sampled foods many unlike anything I have ever known before, rode on elophants, took in the beautiful gold clad Buddhist temples and anieyed scenery and beaches that were vivid with color, energy as well as history.

It is certainly no surprise to me that Thai food with its enchanting spices is finding a stronghold here in our neighborhood culinary collections.
