■ Watch out for the dangerous "toos" — too tired, too cold, too far from safety, too much sun, too much strenuous activity.

■ Don't mix alcohol and swimming. Alcohol impairs your judgment, balance and coordination, affects your swimming and diving skills

and reduces your body's ability to stay warm.

■ Pay attention to local weather forecasts. Stop swimming at the first indication of bad weather.

■ Know how to prevent, recognize and respond to emergencies.

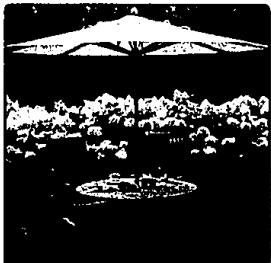
