SPOTLIGHT ON: Orthodontics

BE PREPARED

Orthodontic patients may find that some minor problems may crop up between appointments. For instance, spacers can drop out, or wires may protrude into cheeks. Fortunately, nearly all of these occurrences can be remedied if patients keep some items on hand. These include a pencil with an eraser for pushing errant wires back into place, needle-nosed pliers for grabbing offending ends of wires and bending them into a more acceptable position, and dental wax (to create a buffer between irritating wires or brackets and lips or cheeks). It may also help to have a small mirror around to get a good look at the inside of your mouth in the event there is not a helpful onlooker around.
