

## Pastor takes new posting

Nativity Episcopal Church, Bloomfield Township, has called the Rev. Rod Reinhart to be their interim rector. Nativity is on 14 Mile, one-half mile east of Lahser. Well known for its annual spring art show and the new "Nativity at Nativity," the parish looked for a dynamic preacher and a charismatic leader and found both those qualities in Reinhart.

He is founder of Detroit's People Who Care Ministry, and he is also the founder of the World Sabbath of Religious Reconciliation, the new interfaith holy day of peace among the world's religions.

He recently completed two years as interim rector at Trinity Episcopal Church in Farmington Hills and has served in similar posts in parishes in Detroit and the suburbs.

He has dedicated much of his career to administrating and supporting literary and music programs in Detroit, Monroe, Farmington Hills and Plymouth.

## Jewish book fair seeks local authors

The local author fair will feature 20 local authors. Book fair patrons will have the opportunity to meet the authors and purchase autographed copies of their books.

Detroit's annual Jewish Book Fair is the largest and oldest in the country. Thousands of Jewish books will be available for purchase throughout the 10-day event, which will feature more than 30 speakers. Every speaker's appearance is free and open to the community.
