last on Sunday (in the finals). But we held up in the relays and it was over."

The meet produced a dozen double winners and established seven NSSI records.

Fourteen of the 16 participating teams earned at least one blue-ribbon finish, led by champion Cranbrook with nine individual event championships.

Village Athletic Club finished with eight first place finishes, while Woodside Athletic Club and Livonia Compton-Buckingham had seven each.

Cranbrook's 11- and 12-year-old boys were outstanding, winning four of their five events. Jordan Carter was a double winner, taking the 100 IM and 50 butterfly, while teammates Eddie Rogers (50 back) and James Schlach (50 free) also swam to first place.

Cranbrook's other individual winners were Scott Thompson (50 back), Jen Thompson (50 fly), Caitlin Komeyer (25 back) and Haley Komeyer (50 breast).

The Dolphins' winning boys 52-under, 200-meter medley relay foursome consisted of Scott Thompson, Matt Burke, Zach Devore and Schlach.

"Every single boy we sent (to the meet) scored, and that's tremendous for us," said Moore, who

graduated from Southfield-Lathrup High School and is in her fourth year as the club's head coach.

"We've never had anything like that. The kids just had so much fun. That's our philosophy here - let's work hard, so we can swim fast and have some fun."

The meet's other double winners were Woodside's Dana Olaf (50 back, 50 fly) and Larry Kennedy (50 back, 100 free in a meet record of 51.55). Compton-Buckingham's Jill Peterson (50 free, 60 breast) and Brynn Marek (60 back, 50 free), Beverly Hills Athletic Club's Megan Eyo (100 IM in a meet record time of 1:08.05, 50 breast), Beachwood's Tina Deneweth (50 fly, 50 back), Forest Hills' Danny Priestley (100 IM in a meet record of 1:01.40 and 50 free in a meet record of 24.42), Beechview's Linda McElrean (50 back and 100 IM in a meet record of 1:06.64), Bloomfield Surf's Kristina Njot (25 free, 25 breast), Village Athletic Club's Nicholas Wyllie (25 free, 25 fly) and Heart of the Hills' Trevor Tully (50 fly, 50 back).

Joe Bublitz of Compton-Buckingham set a record of 58.35 in winning the boys 15-18 100 IM.
