

## Retired Salem United Church of Christ minister, Rev. Carl H. Schultz, remembered as a 'community person'

The Rev. Carl H. Schultz, 89, of Cape Coral, Fla., died Aug. 2, 2001, at The Woodlands Assisted Living Facility in Cape Coral.

The Rev. Schultz was born Nov. 17, 1911, in Westphalia, Ind., the son of Charles and Louise Tiek.

He married Barbara H. McArthur May 29, 1938. She survives and resides in Cape Coral.

The Rev. Schultz was Pastor of Salem United Church of

Christ in Farmington from 1936 until his retirement in 1978. He remained active as Pastor Emeritus from 1978 until his move to Florida in 1991.

"He was a community person," said his daughter Jane Long, also of Cape Coral. "He was in all the clubs. He was a wonderful person who touched so many lives. In 41 years, he baptized and married so many people, their children."

"And he had a wonderful

sense of humor. My dad was the kind of guy when he told a joke would laugh before he got to the punch line."

Woodworking, gardening and shooting pool with friends every afternoon were hobbies the Rev. Schultz enjoyed in retirement.

"He was still active in Salem Church after he retired," said his daughter Ruth Frayer, also of Cape Coral. "Former Farmington mayor) Mary Bush was baptized by him."

"And he and mother traveled.

When he retired, the congregation gave them a trip to the Holy Land. And they also visited Alaska, and Hawaii for their 60th anniversary."

In addition to his wife, the Rev. Schultz is survived by children Jon Schultz (Rheda), Steven Schultz (Debbie), Ruth Frayer (Don) and Jane Long (David), 11 grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

Memorial services will be held Aug. 22 at Fort Myers Congregational United Church

of Christ, Fort Myers, Fla.
