Orchard Grove Community Church is looking for a new home.

The congregation has been meeting in the Old Orchard Theatre in Farmington Hills for the past two years. However, the property has been sold and plans are under way for the site on Orchard Lake Road north of 12 Mile to be the new home of an expanded Holocaust Memorial Museum. The current museum has outgrown its location in West Bloomfield.

"We'll have to vacate by November or December," said Pastor Chris Kramer of Orchard Grove Church. "We haven't heard officially yet. We're on a month to month lease with the owners."

The two and a half year old congregation, which met for its first six months in the West Bloomfield High School auditorium, draws about 400 worshippers to its Sunday services at 9 a.m. and 11 a.m.

"They're community celebration services targeted to people who don't attend or haven't attended church in a long time," said Kramer, who was a youth pastor for 10 years before establishing the church. He was affiliated with Bethany Assembly in Adrian.

Walk benefits Alzheimer's association

The ninth annual Memory Walk is a 2K fun walk to benefit the Detroit area chapter of the Alzheimer's Association.

The Memory Walk is the official national fund-raising event of the Alzheimer's Association, with 200 chapters from all 50 states participating. The chapter has set a goal of raising \$175,000, with a team of 1,500 walkers, all joining together to raise funds in support of education, training, in-home and group respite, public advocacy, and support group services to residents with Alzheimer's disease and their families in Wayne, Oakland, Macomb and St. Clair counties.

The walk is slated for 8:30 a.m. Saturday, Aug. 25. Honorary chair is Jim Johnson from "JJ and Lynn" on 94.7 WCSX, over 1,200 walkers and volunteers and numerous corporate sponsors including GE Long term care.

Alzheimer's disease affects 4 million Americans, over 70,000 in the Detroit metro area. Nineteen million Americans say they have a family member with Alzheimer's disease. By the time the baby boomers reach the age of greatest risk, there will be 14 million Alzheimer's victims. Money raised through the Memory Walk provides education, training and support services for local Alzheimer's patients and their families.

Registration forms are available at the Alzheimer's Association office in Southfield. Walkers can participate as individuals or participate in teams. Teams can be corporate, families, friends, churches, or any other organized group ready to have some fun, walk and raise some money for a great cause.

A \$10 registration fee is required for all participants age 3 and older. Register by Friday, Aug. 17. Walk-in registrations or registrations postmarked after Aug. 17 will be \$12.
