

# Seizure Smart programs offer epilepsy awareness

When the only symptoms of a seizure disorder are frequent episodes of blank staring and unresponsiveness, a teacher is often the first adult to notice them. Many children have been diagnosed and successfully treated because of an alert

To create a better under-standing of this disorder and educate teachers on other signa and symptoms of various types of seizures, the Epilepsy Foun-dation of Michigan is offering free "Seizure Smart" epilepsy-education programs. These pro-grams are designed to inform school officials, teachers, bus drivers and students on how to recognize defiferent types of seizures and what to do when a child experiences one. child experiences one.

"With more than 30,000 children in Michigan affected by epilepsy, our goal is to equip teachers with factual informateachers with factual informa-tion regarding seizure identifi-cation and first aid and help eradicate the many myths and stigmas that are often associat-ed with this disorder, said-Arlene Gorelick, president of the foundation.

The foundation also offers the free disability awareness and sensitivity program Attitudes is geared to first and second graders and teaches children to accept and respect people with disabilities. This interactive disabilities. This interactive presentation combines creative discussion, video, hands-on disability simulations and a drawing activity. Taught be a trained volunteer speaker's bureau presenter, this 45-minute program reaches 20,000 to 25,000 studies. dents a year.

Both of the programs will be offered throughout the school year and will be conducted by the foundation's professional staff and trained volunteer
