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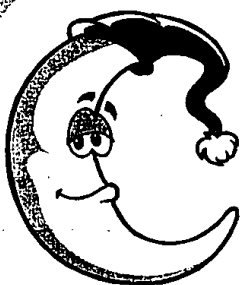

City of Farmington Hills PROPOSED CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE AND EVALUATION REPORT 2000/2001 CDBG PROGRAM YEAR

The City of Farmington Hills has prepared a proposed FY 2000/2001 Annual Performance and Evaluation Report for review by and comments from all interested residents. This document may be reviewed in the Community Development Office, located in the Farmington Hills City Hall, 31555 West Eleven Mile Road, during all regularly scheduled hours of operation from August 31, 2001, through September 17, 2001. At the conclusion of this review period, citizen comments shall be considered for any pertinent revisions of the Consolidated Report.

ONE YEAR ANNUAL PERFORMANCE: The FY 2000/2001 Annual Performance Review describes the available resources, the investment of available resources, the households and persons assisted, and finally, an assessment of the annual performance. The review includes topics such as housing rehabilitation, senior citizen housing, first-time home buyer activities, and rental subsidies.

The Annual Performance and evaluation Report provides information on how the City of Farmington Hills actually used its CDBG Entitlement Funds during the most recently completed program year and an assessment of results and accomplishments of those projects.

Five Year Consolidated Plan: The Five Year Consolidated Plan (FY 1999/00 - FY 2004/05) describes the housing and non-housing needs in Farmington Hills. Comments will be considered for incorporation into the updated annual plan.

PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Farmington Hills will conduct a public hearing for all interested residents on Tuesday, September 11, 2001 at 5 p.m. in the Planning Conference Room of the City of Farmington Hills City Hall, 31555 West Eleven Mile Road, Farmington Hills, MI. The purpose of the hearing will be to obtain the views of interested citizens, public agencies, and other interested parties on the housing needs and housing strategies for Farmington Hills which are reflected in the FY 2000/2001 Annual Performance Report and to consider future projects.
